THAT SUMMER ON THE BALTIC

"Britta and Michael Jarvis were members of the CNS for several years before leaving Canada in their 35 foot sailboat in 1996. Following three years sailing to and in the Caribbean, they crossed the Atlantic Ocean in 1999 and spent the summer of 2000 on the Baltic Sea and neighbouring waters. Their course took them from a starting point near the mouth of the Thames River, where the boat had been left over winter, across the North Sea, through the Kiel Canal and then along the south and east Baltic Sea coasts to St. Petersburg. A month followed on the lakes and rivers of Karelia before returning to St. Petersburg. From there, they sailed westward to Helsinki and Stockholm, transited the Gota Canal to Gothenburg and then, turning south, went on to Denmark and the Kiel Canal. Entering the European canal and river system through Holland, they continued on to Paris and, after overwintering there, to the Mediterranean and Turkey. They left the Mediterranean after three years to return to Canada in 2005."

Their presentation will consist of slides supported by a narrative.
